BYLAW NO. 14/25

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF TISDALE TO OPT INTO THE SAFE PUBLIC SPACES ACT.

The Council of the Town of Tisdale, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting, enacts as follows:

Short Title

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as “*The Safe Public Spaces Bylaw*”.

Purpose

- 2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to opt into the application of *The Safe Public Spaces Act* in accordance with Section 4(1)a of The Safe Public Spaces Regulations, whereas a municipality is required to pass a Bylaw to provide that the Act applies to the municipality.

Opt-In

- 3. The Town of Tisdale hereby opts into the application of *The Safe Public Spaces Act*.
- 4. For the purpose of this Bylaw, street weapons have the same meaning as defined in *The Safe Public Spaces (Street Weapons) Act* and include any item designated, prescribed or otherwise classified as a street weapon under that Act or its regulations, including any other prescribed item.

Coming Into Force

- 5. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the day of its final passing.
